- In consultation with the other cook, prepare menus as agreed with the Proprietor and Manager, observing residents' special dietary needs where appropriate.
- Prepare special diet meals as needed, and as directed through appropriate Diet Sheets / Care Plans. To liaise with Senior Care Staff to keep abreast of any changes in residents' dietary requirements.
- Carry out weekly Deep Cleaning of kitchen.
